1640 Harris Road  
Webster, NY 14580**

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, at approximately 10:55 a.m., the Webster Fire Department was dispatched to the report of a house fire at 1640 Harris Road. The Webster Fire Department was assisted by the Penfield, West Webster, and Lincoln Fire Departments.

First-arriving units encountered a large single-family residence located at the end of a long private driveway with heavy fire showing from the garage and extending into the living area. Firefighters quickly initiated an aggressive fire attack and were able to bring the fire under control. The fire was fully extinguished within approximately 40 minutes.

Due to the heat and challenges associated with the property's accessibility, additional assistance was requested from the Ontario and Fairport Fire Departments. The Monroe County Fire Bureau, Monroe County Sheriff's Office, and Penfield Ambulance also responded to assist at the scene.

Fire crews remained on scene for approximately three and a half hours conducting fire investigation and extinguishing remaining hot spots.

The homeowner was treated on-scene for smoke inhalation. No firefighters were injured during the incident.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
